The actual letter of acceptance shall be submitted before the signing of the contract with the IVF by the end of July of the respective year at the latest. If applying for a Post-Master's scholarship, a letter of recommendation from your home/present university is required (stating that the respective supervisor at the home institution agrees with the proposed stay abroad).

C. Working plan of the study/research period accepted by the host university/institution (should not be older than 3 months when submitting the application).
